WELCOME TO THE VILLAGE

It has often been said that it "takes a village" to raise a child but when I look around our big towns, school systems and busy streets it is hard to see the village. I found my "village" seven years ago when I first attended an Open House at the Mothers Center.

The first group I attended at the Mother's Center was life changing. This discussion group focused the affect of being a mother our day-to-day life, friendships and marriages. Hearing about other women's experiences led to a better understanding and acceptance of changes within myself. It was refreshing to engage in such open communication and feel understood and supported by my peers. Within 8 weeks I knew my co-participants better than I now know some of the moms I've talked to everyday at school pick-up for the last four years.

My village grew when I joined Playgroup, began attending activities, and when I eventually helped out on one of the committees. My son and I were exposed to many new friends and experiences (my first trip to the shore was an MC daytrip).

Eight years into motherhood I can say that I've heard the experiences of many other moms. I bought "THE" book that one mom hailed as the map to a good night's sleep, tried another moms discipline technique... and figured out that our kids and our experiences are just different. I haven't encountered a universal experience or magic bullet but I have become a better listener.



Since that first Open House, I have openly been able to share my thoughts and felt heard, share my small triumphs and felt supported and shared my challenges and been embraced. Beyond just talking, I have played, laughed, danced and cried within this humble space. I am a better person and mother from a much better place.

Perhaps the adage should change to "It take a village to support a mom". That would not be too far from a truth. I hope that this year each of you find a sense of community, support, joy and strength as you navigate this next year in motherhood.

- Conveys Babysitting and Host-site Guidelines to members & coordinates keys for facilitators.

The Steering Committee

(A representative from each committee & all current members are welcome to attend)

- Oversees all aspects of the organization and coordinates the work of all committees.
- Consists of representatives of all the committees and meetings are open to all members.
- Meets monthly to discuss all aspects of the Mothers' Center.
- The agenda is organized and facilitated by the Co-Facilitators.
- All decisions are made by consensus.

The Co-Facilitators of the Steering Committee

(Staci D., Rosie K., & Jessica H.)

Serve as the center's liaison with the National Association of Mothers' Centers, communicate discussion and decisions of the community by keeping minutes of each meeting and troubleshoot with Committees between Steering meetings.

Church Facility Guidelines

- The group may use the building from Monday through Thursday, from 9AM to 12 Noon.
- The rooms that can be used: Nursery, Adjoining (Primary) classroom, Music Room & the two large open areas and kitchen* in the basement. The kitchen can only be use for discussion groups. *No Children are permitted in the basement kitchen at any time.
- All lights must be turned off when leaving the building.
- All doors must be locked when leaving the building.
- All heat and air conditioning must be turned off (down) when leaving the building.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in or outside of the building.
- The Church must be left clean and orderly, including checking any restrooms used (sinks and toilets must be clean) and any floors vacuumed if necessary. Any equipment (chairs, tables, etc.) must be put back as found. Please report any malfunction or breakage of equipment.
- Do not place soiled diapers into church garbage cans. Each parent will have to remove their own child's diapers.
- Any garbage refuse created by a group must be removed at the end of each meeting by the group facilitators.
- The parking lot may be used, however once all the spaces are filled cars must be parked on the street.
- Garwood Presbyterian Church will give 24 hours notice if church is needed for a church activity. Church activities will always have precedence over any activities by the Mothers' Center.



Child Health Guidelines

For the good health of your child and all the children in of the Mothers' Center, please do not bring your child to the Mothers' Center if he/she has:

- Temperature of 99.2 or higher
- Sincere complaints of discomfort
- Swollen glands
- Sore throat
- Excessive discharge from the nose
- Is in the first 3 days of a cold
- Persistent cough or sneezing
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Rash or inflammation of the eyelids
- Extreme lethargy
- Chicken pox
- Rash
- Other contagious disease

Children who have been vomiting and/or had a fever should be kept home for one full day after symptoms have disappeared. Please call or email your facilitator if you will not be attending your group so that we can make the appropriate adjustments in the babysitting room.
